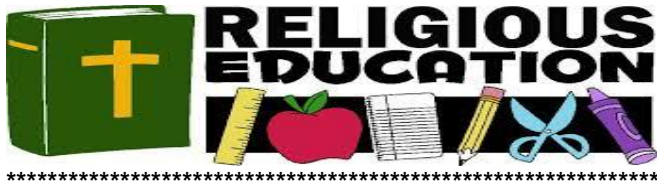

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

**World Mission Sunday** - the annual, worldwide Eucharistic celebration for the Missions of the Church - will be on **October 24** this year. This important day in the life of the Church fortifies our understanding of our shared call to mission, bestowed upon us at Baptism.
