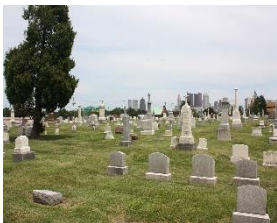

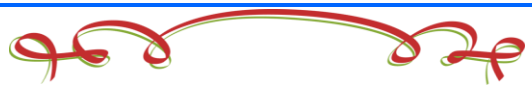

Immaculee Ilibagiza Retreat at St. Andrew Parish in Wray, Colorado, was well attended by ladies from Hoxie on April 9-10.

Immaculee Ilibagiza was born and raised in a small village in Rwanda, Africa. On Easter break in 1994, Immaculee's life was transformed forever when the Rwandan President's plane was shot down. This assassination of the Hutu president sparked months of massacres and a Genocide of Immaculee's Tutsi tribe. To protect his only daughter from rape and murder, Immaculee's father told her to run to a local pastor's house for protection. The pastor quickly sheltered Immaculee and seven other women in a hidden 3 x 4-foot bathroom for the next 91 days. Immaculee's remarkable story is one of faith, forgiveness and Mother Mary.
