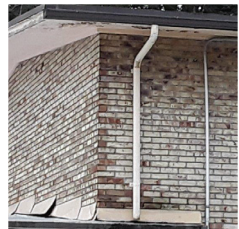
St. Pius X Catholic Church intends to accomplish the following project with its parish share:



IMPROVEMENTS TO SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION BUILDING \$400,000

Built in the 1950s, St. Pius X's School Administration Building needs several improvements. With help from our parish share, our three-year plan to address these needs is:

- **Year 1:** renovate the first floor and add a new stairwell up to the second floor;
- **Year 2:** create conference rooms for parish use on the second floor;
- **Year 3:** replace the boiler and heat distribution system for the school structures and for main church/social hall.



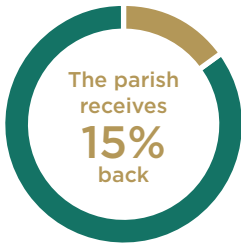
Modernizing the School Administration Building will create a better-functioning school administrative environment as well as space for parish use.



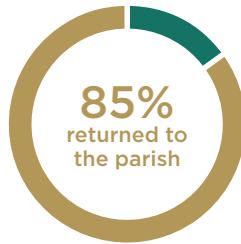
**OUR PARISH CAMPAIGN GOAL:
