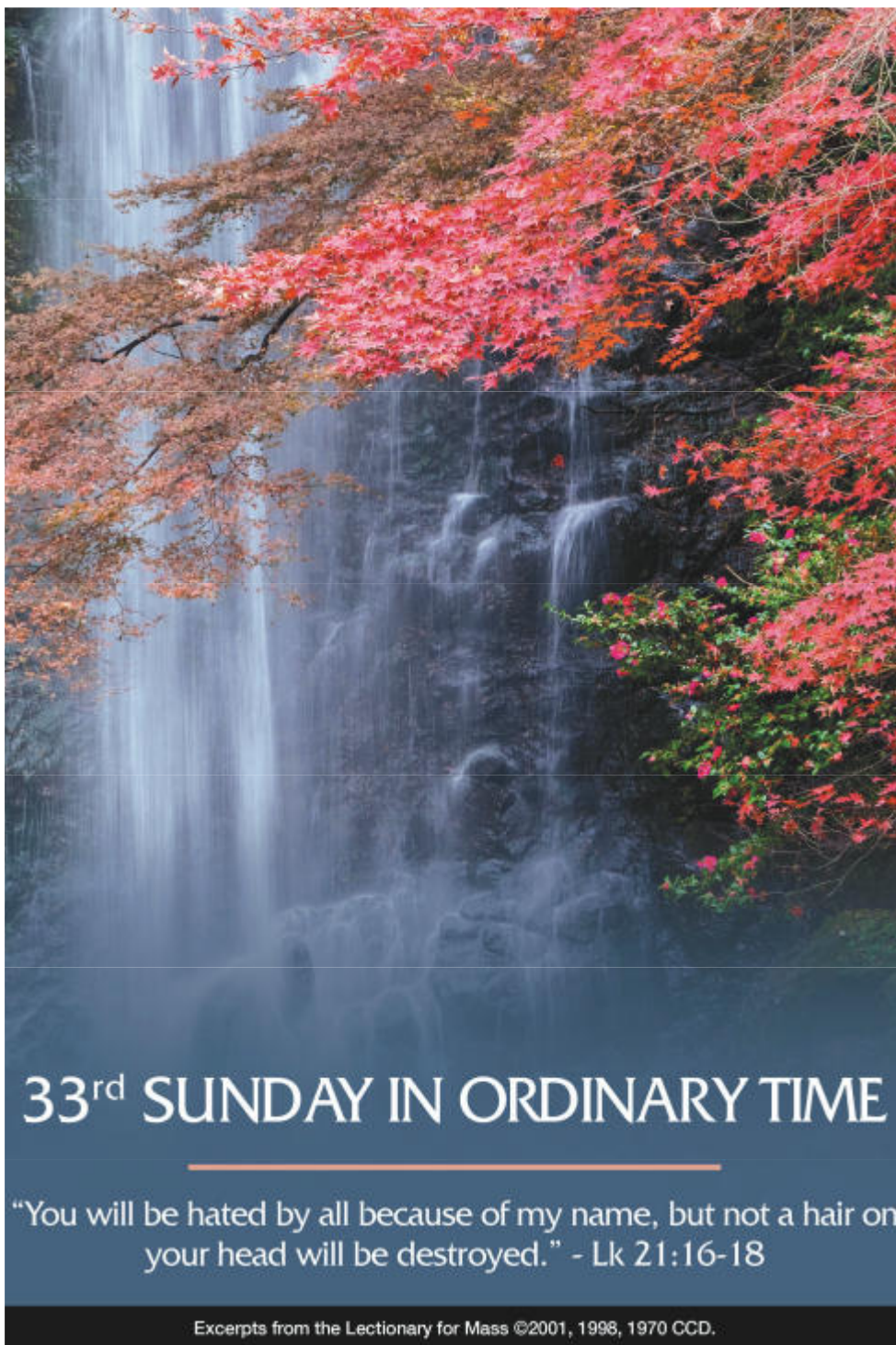

RENEW & REBUILD UPDATE

Since the completion of the pledge portion of the campaign, approximately \$383,238 has been paid. There are however, a substantial number of pledges on which payments either are not being received on a timely basis, or no payment has been received at all. However, of 233 pledges, no payment has been made. Please insure that if you made and if your current situation is such that you can make payments on time, please do so.

INCREASED GIVING

The only source of income for the parish is the generosity of each of the parishioners. The support of the ministries and activities throughout the year and the costs of maintaining the beauty of our Church and grounds are managed and made possible by these contributions. Over the past few months during this year, there has been a noticeable decline in the amounts collected during the Sunday Masses. While there is a constant and concerted effort to control costs and make the best use of the available funds, expenses associated with our utilities, our maintenance and our payments to the Archdiocese tend to increase, while our collections are either remaining the same or slightly declining. This pattern can be offset by small increases in the Sunday mass donations from everyone who is attending. With average attendance ranging from 750 to 1200 people, an increase as low as \$2 per person can have a significant and very positive effect, as we continue to strive to keep the parish of St. Joseph and St. Boniface, a Beacon of Light, Faith and Hope in this community. We truly have come this far by faith, supported by everyone's generosity. Thank you!

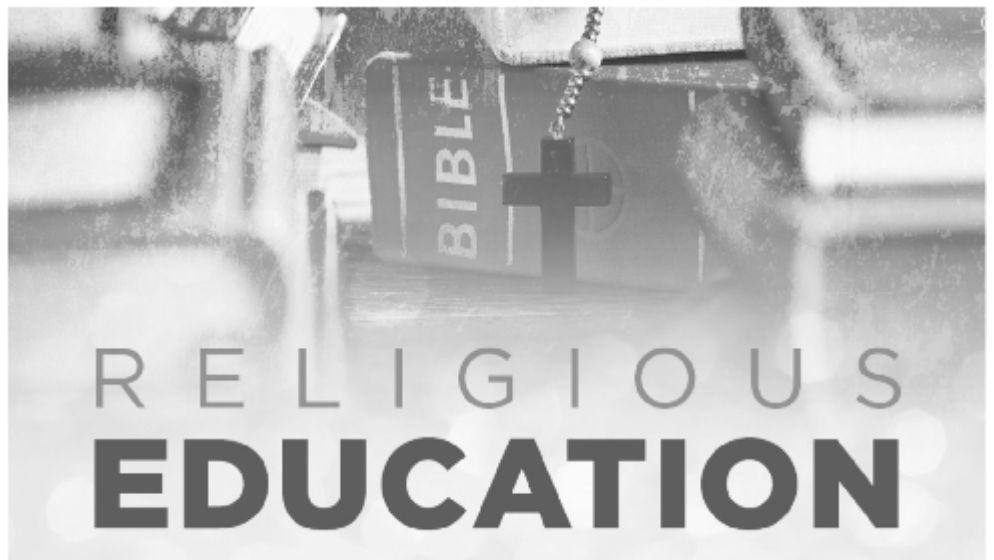

MEDITACIÓN

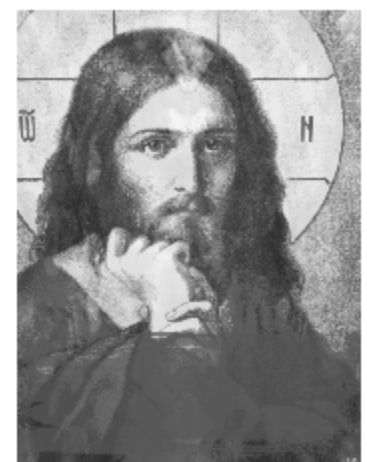

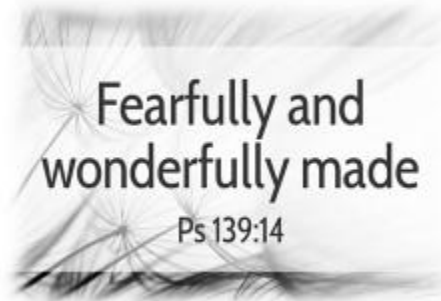

WHY DO WE DO THAT? CATHOLIC LITURGY



QUESTION:

What do Catholics believe about the end of the world?

ANSWER:

We hear the phrase "the end of the world" casually today. Often in film or media, it means the end of civil society or the threat of human annihilation by natural disasters. For the Christian, our perspective is distinctly Christ-centered.

Numerous times through the Gospel, Jesus notes that he will come again, even after he has ascended into heaven. The Church typically refers to this as the Second Coming of Jesus or the Latin "Parousia," meaning "presence" or "arrival."

We believe that Christ will come again, and at his Second Coming, temporal time will end. Human history will end, at least as we know it. However, it doesn't mean that creation will be destroyed. The book of Revelation speaks of a renewal, indeed a "new heaven and a new earth" (Rev 21:1). Christ will come again in glory. Our souls will be reunited with our bodies. While our lives were judged individually at our deaths, which we call the particular judgment, something new will happen here. Theologians call it the general judgment or the last judgment, in which our deeds and the effects — for good or ill — will be known to all. For the early Christians, this second coming was hoped for! They knew it was the completion of God's work of redemption for the human race. We, too, should pray with them, "Come Lord Jesus!"
