## RENEW & REBUILD UPDATE

Since the completion of the pledge portion of the campaign, approximately \$383,238 has been paid. There are however, a substantial number of pledges on which payments either are not being received on a timely basis, or no payment has been received at all. However, of 233 pledges, no payment has been made. Please insure that if you made and if your current situation is such that you can make payments on time, please do so.

## INCREASED GIVING

The only source of income for the parish is the generosity of each of the parishioners. The support of the ministries and activities throughout the year and the costs of maintaining the beauty of our Church and grounds are managed and made possible by these contributions. Over the past few months during this year, there has been a noticeable decline in the amounts collected during the Sunday Masses. While there is a constant and concerted effort to control costs and make the best use of the available funds, expenses associated with our utilities, our maintenance and our payments to the Archdiocese tend to increase, while our collections are either remaining the same or slightly declining. This pattern can be offset by small increases in the Sunday mass donations from everyone who is attending. With average attendance ranging from 750 to 1200 people, an increase as low as \$2 per person can have a significant and very positive effect, as we continue to strive to keep the parish of St. Joseph and St. Boniface, a Beacon of Light, Faith and Hope in this community. We truly have come this far by faith, supported by everyone's generosity. Thank you!

dando oportunidad a una conversión sincera girando el corazón hacia Dios. El protagonista de este domingo y el que viene es Juan Bautista. Con su mensaje, exhorta a la sociedad de hoy a reencontrar el camino y esperar con esperanza cristiana, que es a la vez jubilosa pero exigente en el cambio radical de acciones que destruyen el espíritu de esta temporada. Muchas compras y prisas sin sentido hacen olvidar lo importante del mensaje: "Una voz clama en el desierto: Preparen el camino del Señor, enderecen sus senderos." Significa abrir el corazón a la luz del mensaje. Un corazón sencillo que perdona y experimenta la conversión en pequeños detalles como: una palabra de amor a su familia, aceptar a la persona que no cae bien, o simplemente quitar la cara aburrida de siempre. "Ya el hacha está puesta a la raíz de los árboles, y todo árbol que no de fruto, será cortado y arrojado al fuego." Mas claro el mensaje no puede estar. La presencia salvadora se presenta en este Adviento invitando a hacer obras buenas, preparando y arreglando lo que esta chueco o, como se dice, dejar de hacer tranzas. El Adviento implica ser valientes para hacer el bien. ¿Qué estás dispuesto a cambiar? ¿Qué se debe de enderezar? 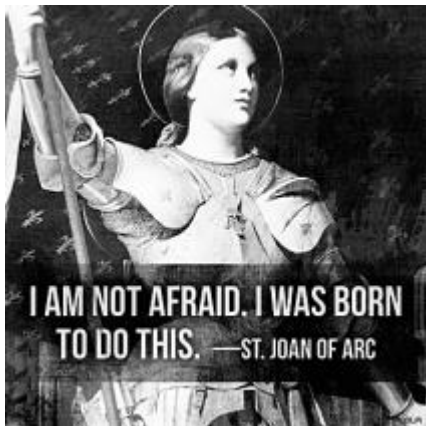

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?



### QUESTION:

What do we know about St. John the Baptist?

### ANSWER:

We know quite a lot about John the Baptist from the Gospels and other historical sources. John was the son of Zechariah and Elizabeth through a graced post-menopausal conception (Luke 1). John would have been raised with an intimate knowledge of Jewish doctrine and religious practice, due to his father being a Levite priest. Elizabeth is a "kinswoman" of Mary. While not in the same nuclear family, the two were close enough that Mary would journey to spend several months with Elizabeth during her pregnancy. We don't know how close John and Jesus were as children, but they certainly knew of one another as cousins.

Luke 3 tells us he began his ministry in "the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberias Caesar," roughly 29 A.D. He lived as a hermit with clear ascetic practices, such as rough clothing and a simple vegetarian diet. Despite his remoteness, John's ministry was prophetic. People came from across the region to be baptized in water as a sign of repentance. John, however, continually pointed beyond himself to the one who was to come: Jesus Christ. John the Baptist's call to repentance extended to the rules of his day. John critiqued the local rulers, Herod Antipas and his wife Herodias. Previously, Herodias had been married to Antipas' brother, Herod Philip, but had betrayed him, left him, and married his more powerful brother. John was arrested for the slight and was eventually executed (Mark 6). This martyrdom prophetically anticipates the trials that awaited Christ and his followers. In life and death, John the Baptist served as the herald of the Messiah.

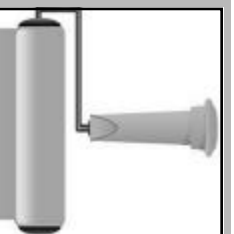
