

NEW GUIDELINES

MASS WILL CONTINUE TO BE STREAMED ON [YOUTUBE](#).

PEOPLE MUST ALWAYS WEAR THEIR MASKS, WASH THEIR HANDS AND USE HAND SANITIZER BEFORE COMING TO CHURCH.

MASS WILL CONTINUE TO BE CELEBRATED AT OUR REGULAR TIMES BUT WITH A LIMIT OF 90 PEOPLE INCLUDING THE PRIEST AND MINISTERS.

WHEN ARRIVING TO OUR PARISH, PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS POSTED IN THE PARKING LOT AND OTHER AREAS.

BEFORE ATTENDING MASS, EACH PERSON HAS TO MAKE LINE AND KEEP A 6 FT. DISTANCE. AT THE ENTRANCE THERE WILL BE USHERS PROVIDING HAND SANITIZER AND GIVING INSTRUCTIONS.

EACH CHAIR IS MARKED FOR SOCIAL DISTANCE. PLEASE AVOID SEATING ON SPACES THAT ARE NOT MARKED WITH A TAPE OR HAVE A CAUTION SIGN.

EACH MASS SHOULD BE LESS THAN 40 MIN AND COMMUNION WILL BE OFFERED AT THE END.

AFTER RECEIVING COMMUNION EACH PERSON IS EXPECTED TO EXIT BY WALKING DIRECTLY TO THEIR CARS AND AVOIDING OUTSIDE GATHERINGS.

THE CHAIRS WILL BE SANITIZED AFTER EVERY SERVICE.
