2019 recipient of William J. Cronin Award

The William J. Cronin Award was established in 2006 to annually recognize an individual, usually a member, who has given selflessly to our children and to the school. This year, it is presented to Mr. Sean O'Reilly, a very familiar and friendly face who we see each weekend outside the Masses at St. Agnes Cathedral.



Sean O'Reilly is as an Executive Manager with the Internal Revenue Service. He attended Miami University, Ohio, where he met his future wife, Anne, and earned his degree in 1990. The O'Reilly's have a son, Liam, who graduated St. Agnes in 2017, and now attends Kellenberg High School.

Sean has been an active member of the Fathers' Club since 2009 and was a board member from 2010-2017. For several years, he co-chaired the annual Super Bowl raffle (now the Mega Raffle), the Dine-out, and Golf Outing.

Over the past decade, and continuing today, Sean has lead by example in his good will and philanthropy, shaving his head, with his son Liam for St. Baldrick's Fundraiser. In fact, he created a Fathers' Club team to shave for St. Baldrick's and coordinates the cleanup of the Parish Center after the event. When a Fathers' Club member became ill in 2010, and in need of blood, Sean Co-chaired the creation of a blood drive. Now in its tenth

year honoring his memory they have collected some 1,851 pints of blood.

But Sean doesn't stop there. He is also an active member of the Cathedral Parish, serving as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, supporting the Parish's Giving Tree Ministry and chairing, with his wife, Anne, the 2018 annual Parish Celebration.

Sean's dedication to our community's young people extends beyond the parish, as he continues to help lead local Cub Scout and Boy Scout Units. He has been a Cubmaster, committee chair, Scoutmaster and serves currently as the organization's charter representative & merit badge counselor. On weekends, he and Anne can be heard cheering on Liam in running races for the Firebirds all around our region.

The St. Joseph Award was established in 2007 to recognize those extraordinary individuals who have touched our community and set examples for our children. This year, it is presented to Mr. John Bender, a close friend to our club and someone we are very fortunate to be able to call our neighbor. The Fathers' Club has been privileged to support and assist the local St. Baldrick's event run by John's wife, Alanna.



John Bender is currently Chief Executive Officer for Allied World's Global Reinsurance operations and a board member since 2007. Prior to joining Allied World, John served from 2002-2007, as the Chief Underwriting Officer – Casualty at Platinum Underwriters. From 1989 - 2002, John had many roles the treaty underwriting and claims departments of St Paul Re, and was a principle member of the management team that spun-off of St Paul Re to Platinum Underwriters.

John was part of the last graduating class of St. Agnes High School here in Rockville Centre. He went on to St John's University, receiving his degree in marketing. He remains active with St. John's through its Alumni programs and activities. John enjoys attending St. John's basketball games with his family. John and Alanna have three children; Shannon, Brady & Casey. John attends as many family sporting events and dance recitals that his time allows. But he spends much of his free time working with the St Baldrick's Foundation to help find a cure for childhood cancer. He is a Founder & Chairman Emeritus of the St Baldrick's Foundation and a current Board Member. Through the foundation's efforts, over 200,000 people have shaved their heads in solidarity with children throughout the world who are fighting this horrible disease. Through their efforts more than \$160 million has been granted to fund cutting-edge research to help find a more humane cure, so that all children will one day live happy, healthy lives free from the specter of cancer. The St Baldrick's Foundation stands now as the largest non-governmental funder of childhood cancer research in the world.
