Do you TRUST God?”

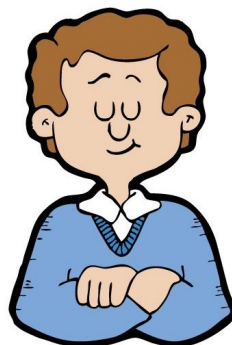
