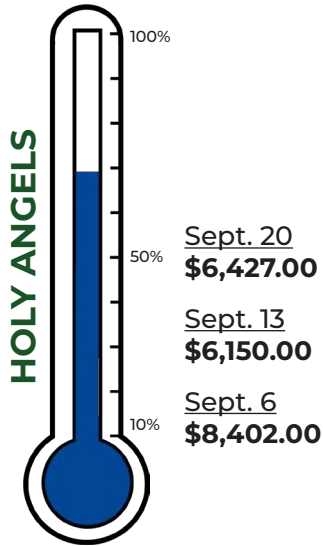

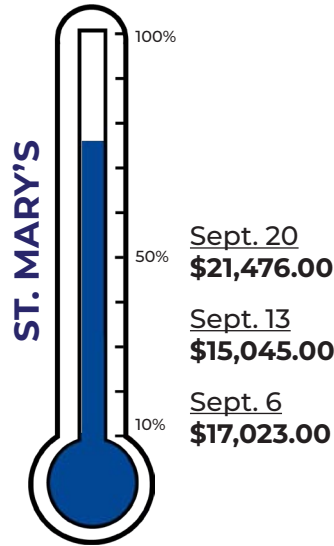

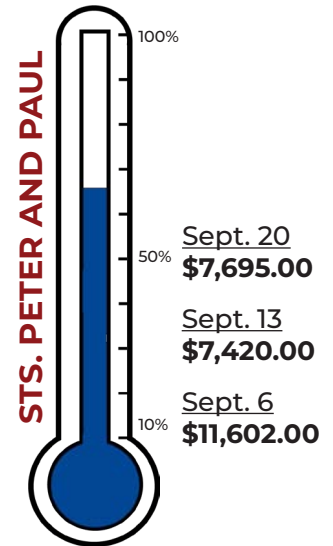

Greetings Fellow Parishioners,

It is great to have the students and staff of Sandusky Central Catholic School back on our campus, or attending classes online through our Remote Access to Live Instruction (RALI) program. Our two-week phased start-up allowed everyone to get acclimated with implemented procedures to help provide a safe environment for all. That adjustment period provided a great foundation for the past two weeks with full in-person classes.

We are grateful for the generous donors through whose support we have implemented a variety of enhanced health and safety measures throughout the school. All students and staff members were issued reusable cloth masks and water bottles. We have also installed hand sanitizing stations at all entrances, replaced standard drinking fountains with "bottle filler" stations, purchased electrostatic sprayers used by our custodial staff during nightly cleaning of the building, and increased the availability of our school nurse during the school day.

It is through support like this that SCCS continues to *Make a Difference* for our families, our parishes and our community. Together we have created a vision for Catholic Education that is rooted in our 100+ years of rich tradition preparing students to be successful for college, the armed forces and the workforce, all while creating lifelong memories. 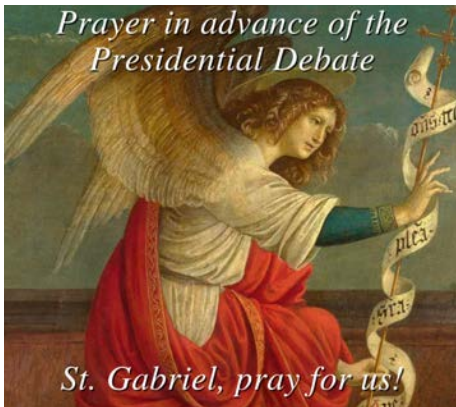

Sept. 27 - St. Gabriel

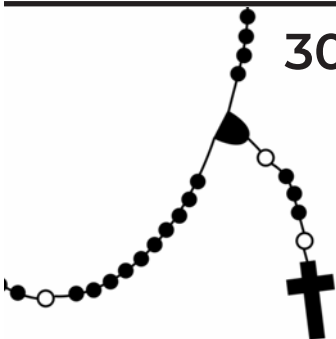

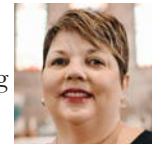

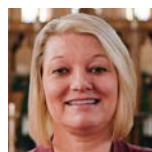
