**Today is the Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time**



**DISCIPLINE.** It is no accident that the words “disciple” and “discipline” are nearly identical. Their relationship in Christian faith and life, however, has fallen somewhat out of favor in the past generation, as certain prescribed Church rules and regulations have been reduced and relaxed. These rules were often referred to as “disciplines.” We are mistaken, however, to think that it no longer takes discipline to follow Christ. The Letter to the Hebrews assures us of that today. Our discipline is more like that of an athlete pursuing a victory or a personal best, or a musician striving for a concert career or to master a new piece of music. This discipline comes from desire, not from regulations. It was the desire to do the will of God that led Jesus on the path to his cross. It is that same desire he encourages in us today: to strive to enter through the narrow gate, to find ourselves in the kingdom with a surprising assortment of people who are there not because of mere observance of rules, but out of a genuine desire to recline at the table of the heavenly banquet.

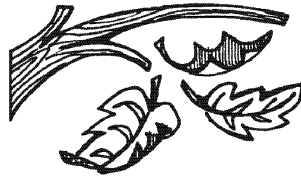

## **The Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time** *Reflecting on God's Word*

Trudy hung up the phone very slowly. “Well, Jim, there’s good news and bad news. The good news is that your mom and dad are coming to Kate’s wedding after all. The bad news is that your brother is coming with them.” Jim’s brother was a missionary for a strict religious sect. When he had learned that Jim and Trudy were becoming Catholic he had erupted in condemnation. They had not spoken since then.

Have you ever hoped someone would not come to an event you were hosting, or scheduled it when you knew the person wouldn’t be available? Are there people whose presence in the seat next to you at Sunday Mass would make you uncomfortable? Today’s scriptures proclaim that those people have as much right to “recline at table in the kingdom of God” as we do ~ or more. They suggest that if we want the Lord to “open the door for us,” we must be willing to open the door to everyone. ~ *Virginia Stillwell*.

### **Living God's Word**

*Many of us wish that certain people were outside the reach of God's love.*

*Surrendering that illusion can be “a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness” (Hebrews 12:11).*
