

YOUR BICENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN DOLLARS HARD AT WORK!
Many thanks to all who made pledges this week to the Bicentennial Campaign.

We received additional pledges this week of \$17,250! We are grateful for EVERY pledge made regardless of the amount pledged. Every dollar helps!!!

The current total of pledges made is now **\$849,840!** Based on the percentages set by the diocese that means that the parish will receive **\$465,130** towards our Vision 2020 goals for campus improvements in support of our many parish ministries and programs. Work continues in St. Andrew Hall. Ten new, insulated and tinted windows have been ordered and will be installed in the coming weeks. The corner of the room has been sheet rocked and painted to prepare for hanging the statue of the Holy Family, Jesus, Mary and Joseph, to take pride of place. The platform is ready for new carpet.

The stained-glass windows that were in St. Andrew Hall have been removed and work is continues to install them in the Adoration Chapel.

With the success of our Bicentennial Campaign we are receiving bids on the following work to be completed in the near future as one project:

- Add curb and pave the area where the Men's Club collects cans.
- Grade and stone a new road around the cemetery.
- Remove the center island in the parking lot, grade, add curb and gutter, pave and stripe for additional parking
- Add 4 feet of width to the existing sidewalk along the front of the Admin building all the way to the Family Life Center.
- Install new concrete sidewalk to grass parking area
- Install new loading dock at kitchen to replace dock that is collapsing. Infill where old dock was located.
- Add new drain box and pipe in front of Family Life Center and regrade alongside enclosed stair way to direct storm water away from building and prevent flooding at entrance.

Additional projects include renovations to the exterior and interior of the Family Life Center, exterior and interior signage improvements, exterior lighting improvements, a fountain and larger plaza in front of the church and improvements to the parish graveyard (Columbarium Project!). These projects are all dependent on the Bicentennial Campaign and will be completed as funds are received through the Catholic Community Foundation. (Funding was previously received for the fountain and parking lot improvements. Most of the improvements to the graveyard will be financed through the sale of grave sites and columbaria niches.)
