

## What does this mean for Our Lady of the Lake?

Until 1 April the following steps will be taken:

- All masses at OLL will no longer be public. Daily Mass and at least one Sunday Mass will be celebrated by Fr. Dennis alone. Mass intentions will be honored to the fullest extent possible.
- All pastoral visits are cancelled. Communion to the sick and home bound visits are cancelled. Hospital and Nursing home visits are cancelled.
- The parish will make an effort to reach out to all the sick and homebound to help with any needs they may have to include having volunteers drop off needed items but person to person contact must be avoided.
- All public events at the parish are cancelled.
- If you or a loved one are in danger of death and need a priest for Last Rites then please call Fr. Dennis at 843.834.5447. All other pastoral visits are suspended until further notice.
- The parish offices will remain open during our regular business hours. We ask that you limit visits to the office. Most business with the parish should be easily done through email or phone calls.
- The church will be open during the day for prayer. As per the Bishop's letter the Adoration Chapel will be closed.
- Please continue to support the parish through on-line giving or by sending a check in the mail. We are dependent on your generosity. Thank you in advance for your gifts.
- The Bicentennial Campaign will continue. It will be a true test of our Faith to commit to a five year pledge during this time of uncertainty. Hopefully we will all be able to trust that this too shall pass.
- The diocese will re-evaluate these steps on 30 March. You will be notified of any and all changes at that time.
