 - Did you know? No two fingerprints are alike. Even identical twins, who share the same DNA, don't share fingerprints. Each of your fingers has a unique print. Even the same kind of finger (thumb, pinky etc) has different prints.
 - Reflection: Notice the absolute uniqueness of every human person. In what other ways are we all unique? In what other ways are we all similar?
