Rehearsal:

Rehearsal for Confirmation will be on Sunday, April 21st in the Church from 5:30 pm – 6:30 pm. The Sponsor (or a parent if the Sponsor is not available) should accompany the Candidate. Instructions for the Sponsor are given at this time.

Confirmation:

Confirmation will be on Tuesday, April 21st at 7:00pm in the Church. The Candidate and the Sponsor should arrive at 5:30 pm.

A photographer has been hired and she will be available starting at 5:30 pm that evening in the Parish Life Center for photos with family, the candidate and their sponsor. A group photo will be taken before the Confirmation mass as well.

Photography envelopes and forms will be handed out at the rehearsal and we will have additional forms available the night of Confirmation. Cash or Check are accepted and all photos are shipped directly to you.

Friends and family are certainly welcome and encouraged to attend the Confirmation, but you should arrive early to secure seating for them. *Seating for parents is not reserved, so come early to get your seat.*

There will be RESERVED seating for the Candidate and the Sponsor. The rest of the pews are on a first come, first serve basis.

Apparel:

Boys – It is suggested a solid color shirt (light or dark), solid color dress slacks, a tie would be nice and a sport coat is optional. Additionally, dress shoes should be worn.

Girls – A dress or modest skirt and blouse are suggested. Please NO strapless or spaghetti string dresses or sleeveless tops for this *Sacred event*. A shrug or light weight sweater over top of a dress with small straps is appropriate, but baring your shoulders is not appropriate at this event. I would not suggest extremely high shoes to be worn as the floor can be very slick in spots and we would not want anyone to hurt themselves. Purses are NOT needed. Dresses do NO HAVE TO BE WHITE. They can be any color or pattern.

JEANS, ATHLETIC FOOTWEAR, AND FLIP-FLOPS ARE INAPPROPRIATE FOR BOTH BOYS AND GIRLS AT CONFIRMATION.

Photographs:

Please do not take pictures in the Church during the ceremony. No flash photography is allowed during the ceremony. You may take pictures of your child after the mass. The Bishop will be happy to be in the photos as well as the clergy.

A photographer has been hired and she will be available starting at 5:30 pm that evening in the Parish Life Center for photos with family if you so desire. She will begin at that time photographing the Candidate and their sponsor and a shot of just the Candidate.

Reception:

Once the photo has been taken, there will be a reception in the Parish Life Center. All are welcome!
