Information

Kindergarten

- ★ Students will be introduced to technology such as chromebooks, iMacs and iPads. Students will learn how to use Google Classroom and participate in assignments posted there. This will help serve as a teaching the tech skills that teachers will then use with their core classes.
- ★ Students will also learn age appropriate digital citizenship and online safety.
- ★ During in person learning students will receive a rating on the report card that indicates students participation and cooperation during class.

First Grade

- ★ Students will continue to develop their technology skills using Google Classroom. Assignments will be run through Classroom as often as possible so navigation skills become easier.
- ★ Students will also explore other applications such as Flipgrid, Book Creator, Google Docs, Google Slides, Google Forms and be introduced to basic coding throughout the year.
- ★ Students will also learn age appropriate digital citizenship and online safety.
- ★ During in person learning students will receive a rating on the report card that indicates students participation and cooperation during class.

Second Grade

- ★ Students will continue to refine their skills with Google Classroom and the Google Suite Products.
- ★ Students will have a chance to explore Flipgrid, Book Creator, basic coding, and spend time learning about good digital citizenship and online safety.
- ★ During in person learning students will receive a rating on the report card that indicates students participation and cooperation during class.

Third Grade

- ★ Students will continue to refine their skills with Google Classroom and the Google Suite Products such as Google Docs, Slides, and Sheets.
- ★ Students will have a chance to explore Flipgrid, Google Earth, coding, and begin to learn formal typing skills to increase their abilities.
- ★ Students will learn basic online research skills and spend a lot of time learning about digital citizenship and safety.
- ★ Students will earn an effort and conduct rating during in person lesson. Please see the Specials Grading sheet sent home (also posted on website) for the effort/conduct expectations.

Distance Learning Note

- ★ If we have a distance learning experience this school year, technology classes will be suspended. Mrs. Thompson and myself will be available through email or Google Meets if students, teachers or parents have technology issues or need help. Please know we are there to support distance learning and will be a “co-teacher” in each classroom so we can help. If you experience issues, please reach out to your student’s teacher, Mrs. Thompson or myself so we can assist during that time.
