General Music Information
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Grades K-2

- ★ Students will be taking a general music class one time a week. During music K-2 students will have the opportunity to explore rhythm, sounds, basic notation, age appropriate music history, independent folk dancing, movement with music, rhythm instruments, and guided listenings.
- ★ Students will be put into a Google Classroom in case we end up in a distance learning situation. Quaver's Marvelous World of Music will be used with these students along with many other age appropriate resources.
- ★ Students will be given a rating based on participation and cooperation for music activities. The scale is the same as used in the classrooms.

Grades 3-4

- ★ Students will be taking a general music course. In this course students will have the opportunity to explore rhythm, pitch relationships, harmony, notation, and form through music composition, music history, independent folk dancing, rhythm instruments and listening projects. (Fourth grade recorders will be put on hold for the time being)
- ★ Students will use Google Classroom and Quaver's Marvelous World of Music both in class and if we are to do distance learning among other resources.
- ★ Students will receive their effort and conduct grades for music. Please see the Specials Grading sheet sent home (also posted on website) for the effort/conduct expectations.

Grades 5-6

- ★ Students will be taking a general music course. In this course students will have the opportunity to explore rhythm, pitch relationships, harmony, notation, and form through music composition, music history, listening projects.
- ★ Students will use Google Classroom, Flat for education (using their Google accounts), O-Generator (accounts provided) among tradition learning methods.
- ★ Students will receive their effort and conduct grades for music. Please see the Specials Grading sheet sent home (also posted on website) for the effort/conduct expectations.

Junior High

- ★ Students will be taking a general music course. In this course students will have the opportunity to explore rhythm, pitch relationships, harmony, notation, and form through music composition, music history, listening projects.
- ★ Students will use Google Classroom, Flat for education (using their Google accounts), O-Generator (accounts provided) among tradition learning methods.
- ★ Students will receive a letter grade whether we are in person or distance learning. An effort/conduct grade will be provided if we are in person.
