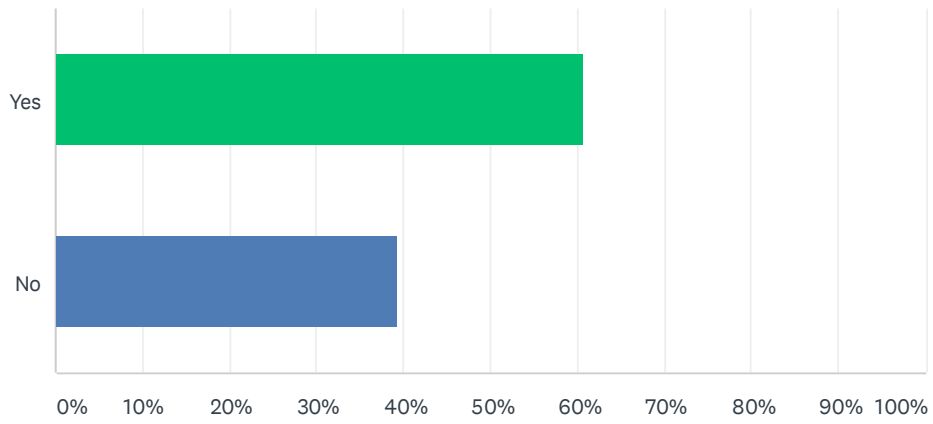


# Q1 In the past two years have you toured the rectory for which Fr. Tim resides?

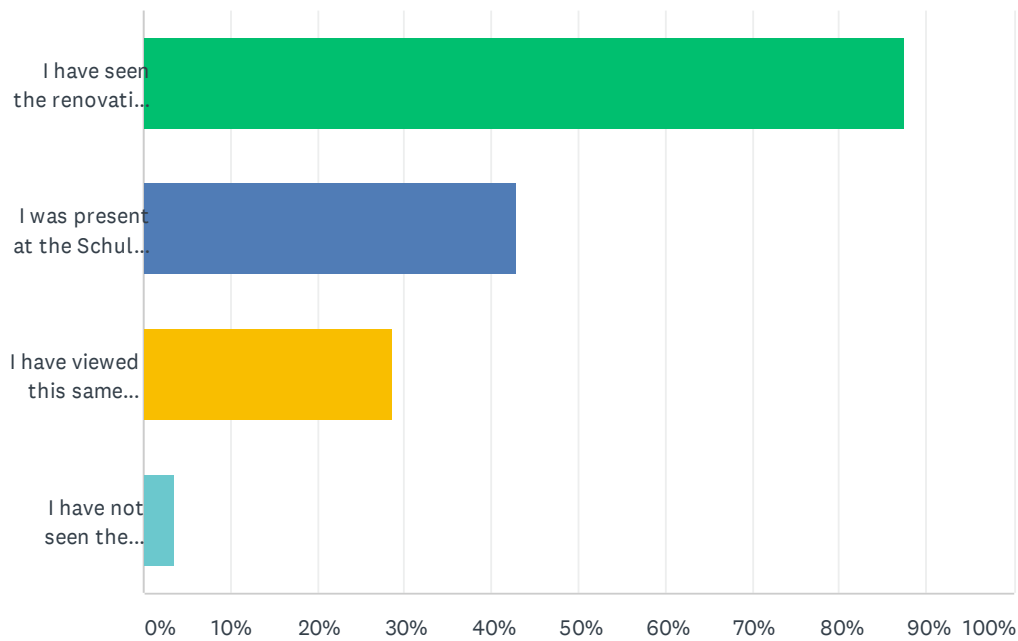

## Q2 Please check all answers that are applicable in regards to your knowledge of the parish renovation project

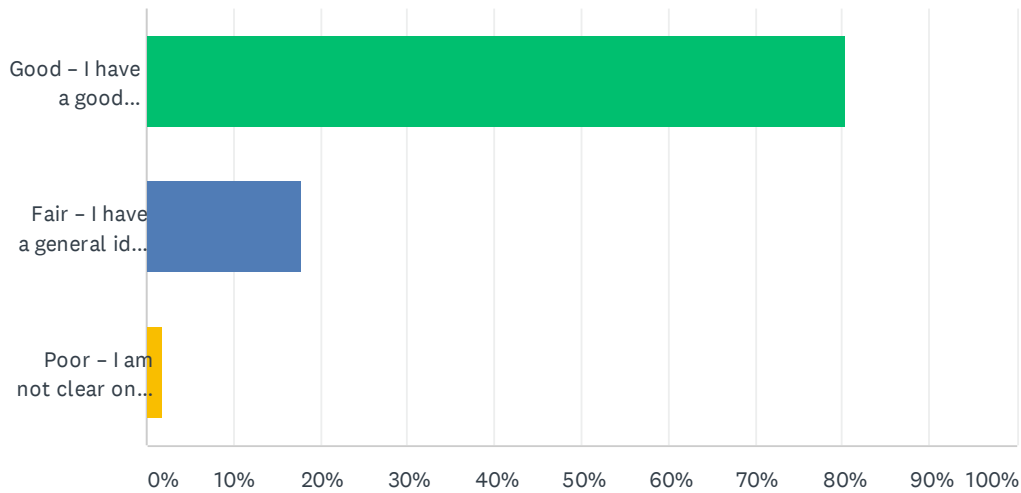

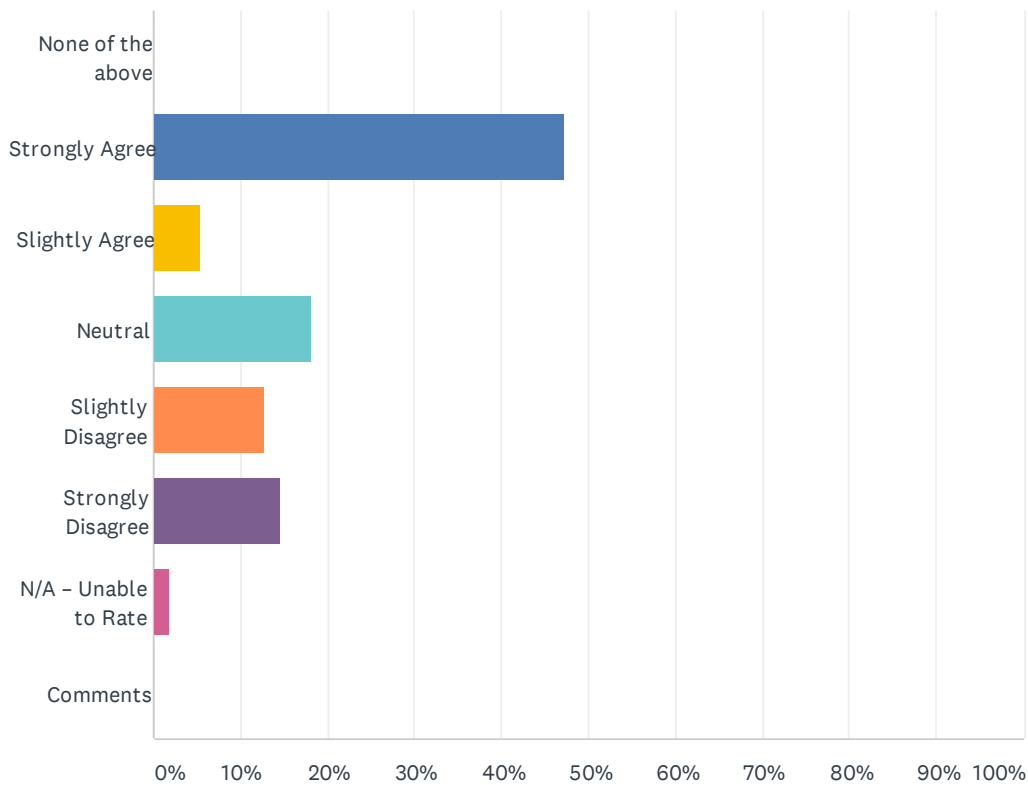

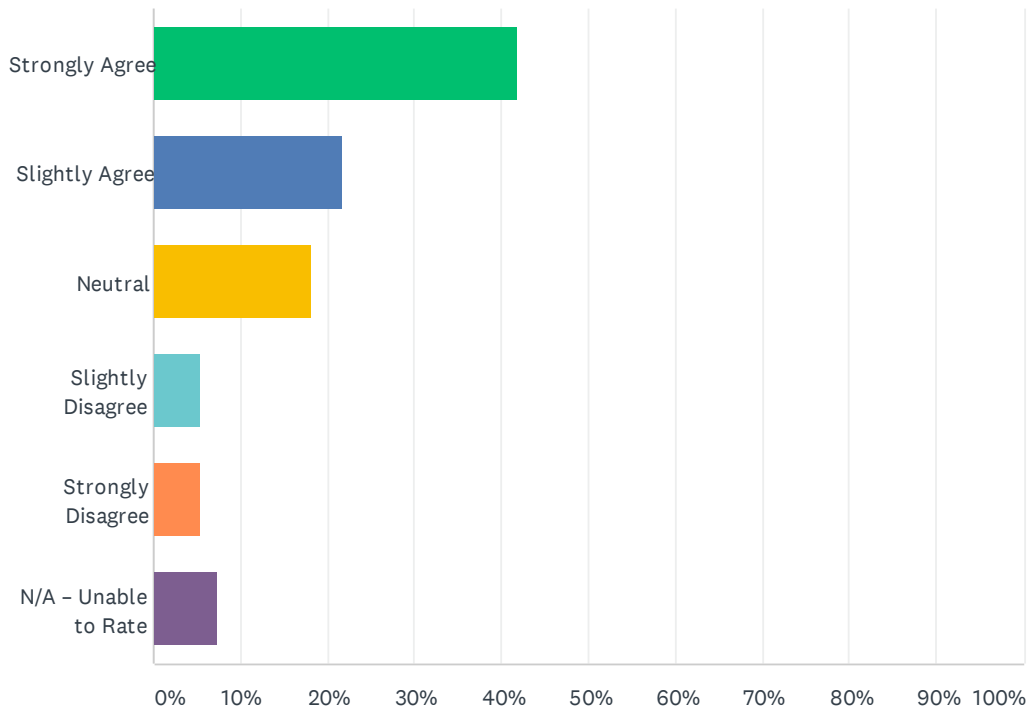

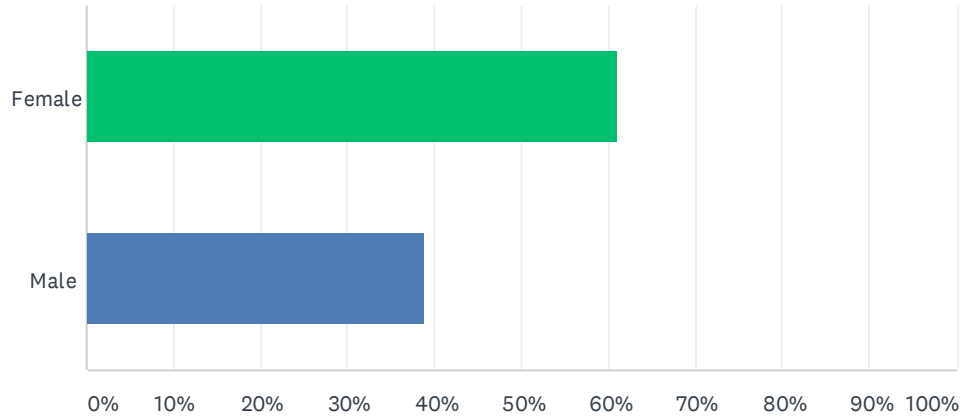

### Q17 What is the gender of the survey respondent?

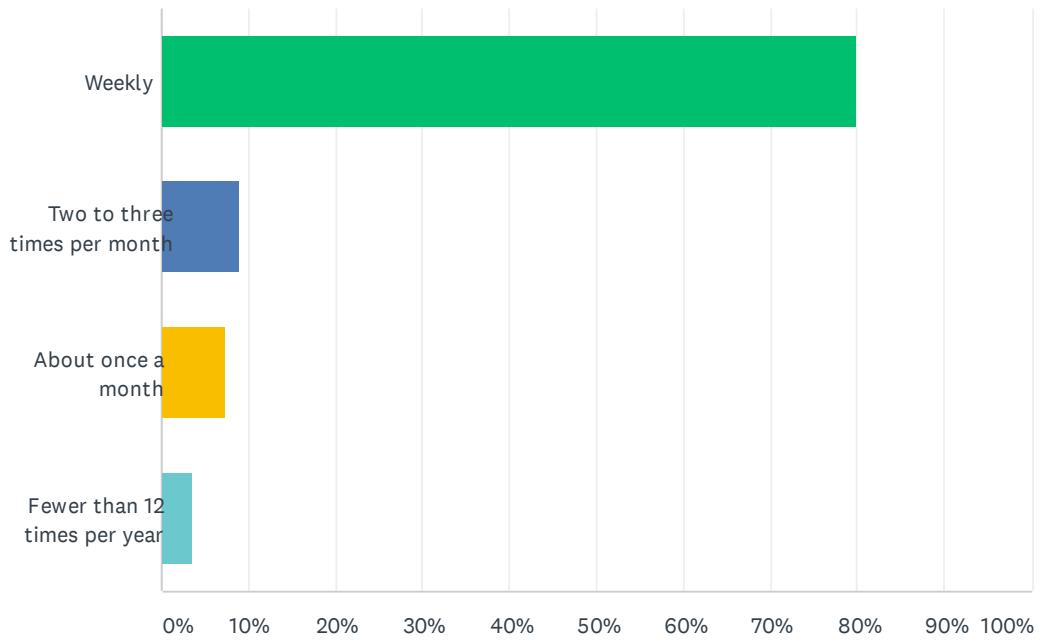

## Q18 How frequently do you attend services here at St. Charles Borromeo each month?

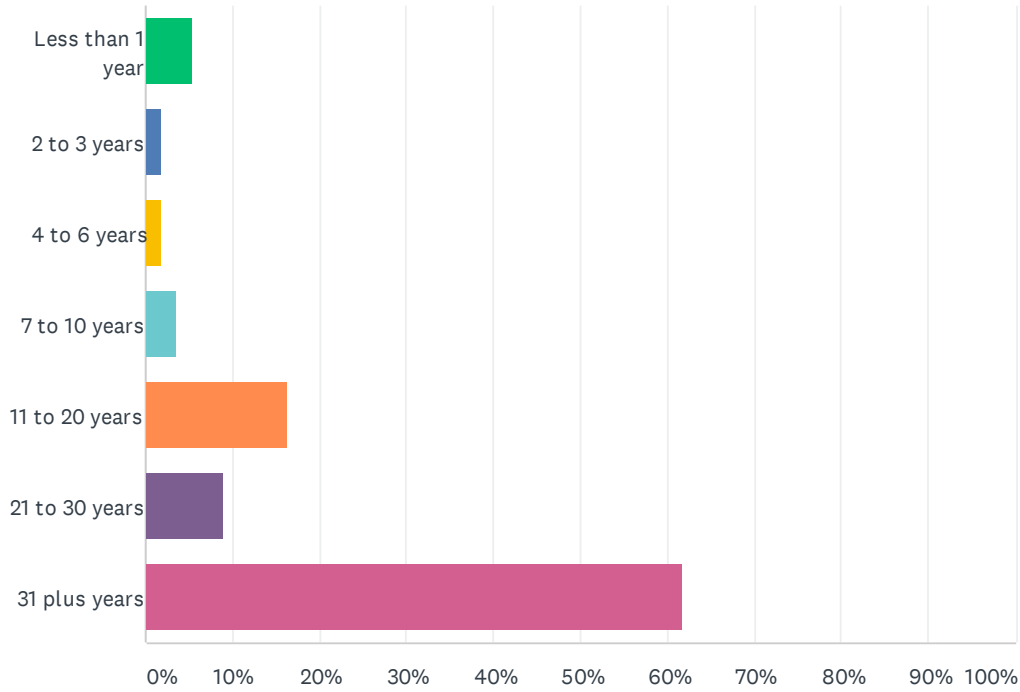
