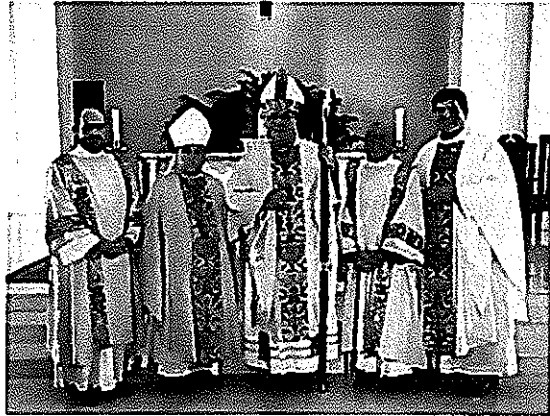

The Diocese of Birmingham in Alabama currently has ten men studying for the priesthood. This is both a blessing from God and a sign of a maturing diocese. The average cost per student per year is \$35,000 which includes tuition, room and board. 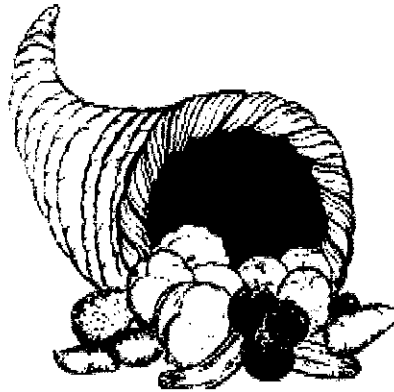

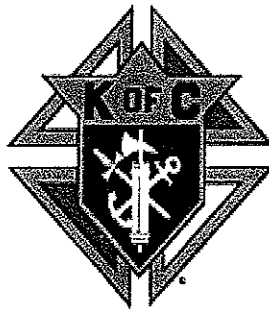
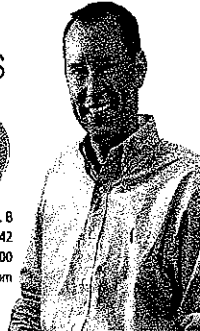
