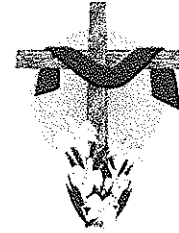

## Youth

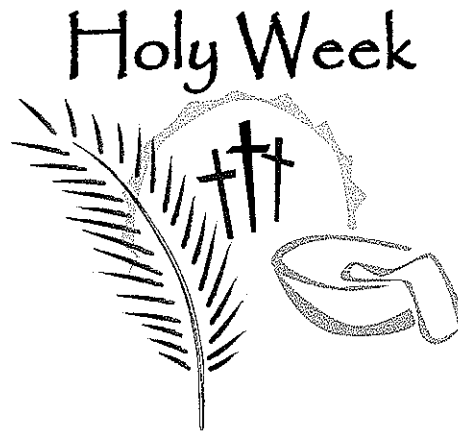

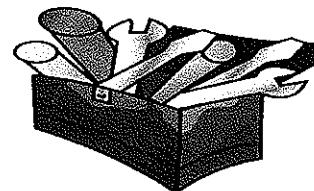
