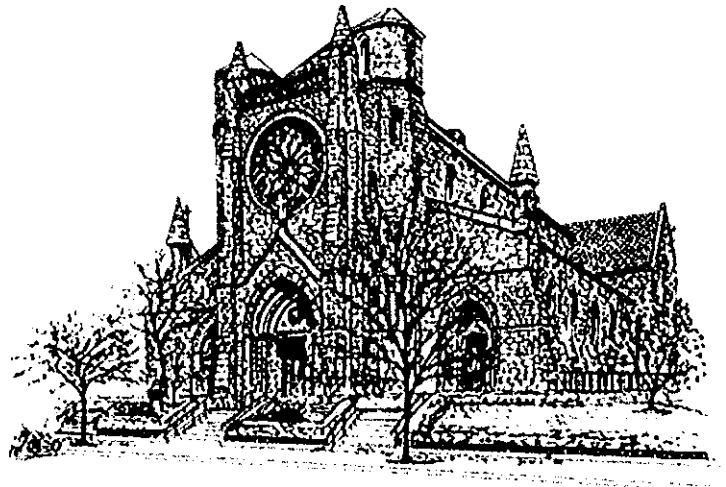
Registered parishioners preparing for
