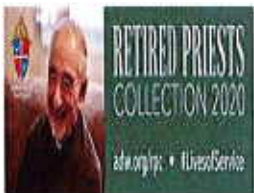
They lived the scripture passage above, and their hope and Jesus’ promise has been fulfilled. This is why we celebrate today. Make your choice, choose to be a saint today.
