

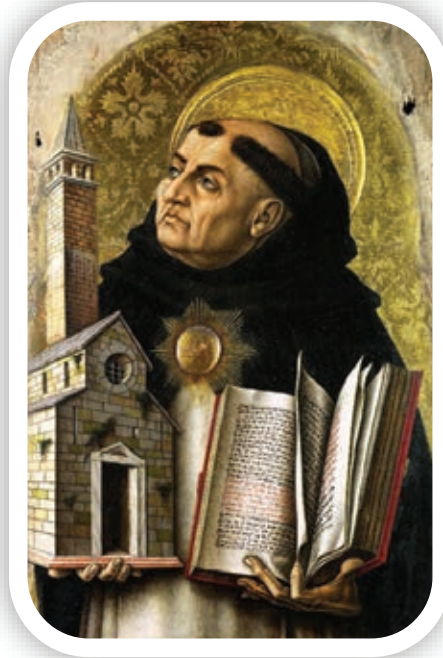

## COVID-19 UPDATES

As you know, the Commonwealth of PA recently announced that the counties of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia will be moving into the Green Phase of re-opening, beginning June 26th. Listed below are some of the directives for the Open "Green" Phase of the Archdiocesan re-opening:

1. Everyone (except those 2 years of age and younger) attending Mass is strongly encouraged to wear a face covering or mask throughout the celebration of the Mass but it is not required.
2. Reservations are no longer required to attend daily Mass in the Chapel.
3. The Parish Office will resume normal business hours beginning the week of July 13th.
4. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion may resume bringing Holy Communion to the homebound.

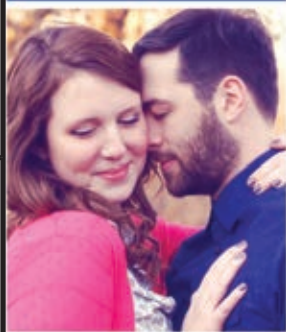
