

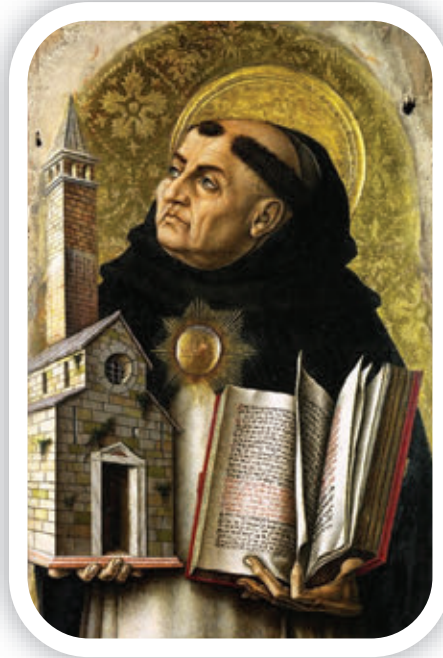

May 2021

Dear Parishioners,

Before we move into the summer months, I want to express my gratitude to all those who have worked hard to enhance our Holy Week, Easter, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion liturgies as well as our St. Joseph Triduum. In addition, I am grateful to Tom and Charles Litz for repainting the outdoor Stations of the Cross.

As Covid-19 restrictions are gradually lifted and more people get vaccinated, we hope to resume more of our parish activities. Some events are possible under current social distancing guidelines: the Blessing of Animals, the Malvern Retreat House Speaker, the Parish Memorial Mass, the Parish Picnic, and even our Sunday Social. Other events require a further relaxation of the health rules: Soup and Conversation, Parish Breakfast, the Halloween Party, and the Christmas Bizarre. The Community and Unity Dinner will have to be postponed until all restrictions on indoor gatherings are lifted. I am attaching a brief survey to try to gauge the willingness of parishioners to participate in different activities. Please take a few minutes to fill it out and return it in the collection or by mail to the parish office.

Here is an update on the latest news:

- The Most Reverend Nelson Perez, Archbishop of Philadelphia, will offer the 11AM Mass on Sunday, May 1, 2022 as we give praise and thanksgiving to Almighty God for the 65<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the dedication of our church.
- We hope to hold the Annual Parish Picnic on Sunday, September 12<sup>th</sup>! Volunteers are needed. Last time we had the Picnic, Russell Andrews oversaw the event. Sadly, Russ and his family have moved to Massachusetts. If anyone is interested in taking a lead role in the Picnic, please let me know. We need and welcome new and younger faces to take on positions of leadership in our parish.
- As you may have guessed, our parish finances have been adversely affected by the pandemic. Collections are down about 15%. In an attempt to make up some lost ground, the Finance Council has agreed to join in a raffle hosted by St. Roch Parish in Greenwich, CT. The top prize is an American Express gift card worth \$30,000! Every family in the parish will receive these tickets in the mail.
- The 50/50 drawing is July 4<sup>nd</sup>. You have to play to win!
- As more and more people get vaccinated, Mass attendance is slowly bouncing back. I invite you to consider returning to the in-person celebration of the Eucharist as soon as you are able. Virtual reality is a poor substitute for the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist!
- Also, if you are aware of any parishioner who is unable to attend Mass because of age or infirmity, please call the parish office so that the sacraments can be brought to him or her. Every so often I am saddened to learn of a practicing Catholic who was homebound for years without the benefit of the sacraments and the graces that they bestow!
- If you were married outside the Catholic Church, please consider having your marriage convalidated or “blessed in the Catholic Church.” An invalid marriage is an impediment to receiving a Letter of Eligibility to be a sponsor for Baptism and Confirmation and to the worthy reception of the Blessed Sacrament. Please keep in mind that for some years now the Archdiocese of Philadelphia hasn’t been charging those who have applied for an annulment.
- The sale of the school has not yet been finalized. Habitat for Humanity is in the process of obtaining grants for the demolition of the building and the removal of any asbestos and the underground oil tank. Good things come to those who wait!
- The Pastoral Council unanimously recommended removing the art work that surrounds the crucifix behind the main altar. If you see any reason why this work should not proceed, please let me know as soon as possible.

Enjoy the summer. Take a rest from work and school. Never take a vacation from God! My friends, Google and Siri, know where the nearest Catholic Church is located. Don’t forget that your parish still depends on your continued generosity—even when you are traveling.

**Property Tax Rebate.** To help with the rising cost of living, you are reminded that Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program applications are now available. There are new guidelines which will permit individuals that qualify to receive a rebate between \$250 and \$650 from property taxes or rent paid last year. Funding for this rebate program is made possible by the PA State Lottery Fund and is a rebate that does not have to be repaid. **This application must be filed by June 30, 2021.** To qualify, you must be 65 years of age or older, a widow or widower 50 years of age or older, or a disabled person 18 years or older. Homeowners that have annual incomes of \$15,000 or less could qualify. Only half of your annual Social Security or SSI income is counted toward the income guideline. 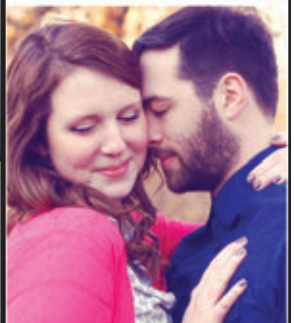
