

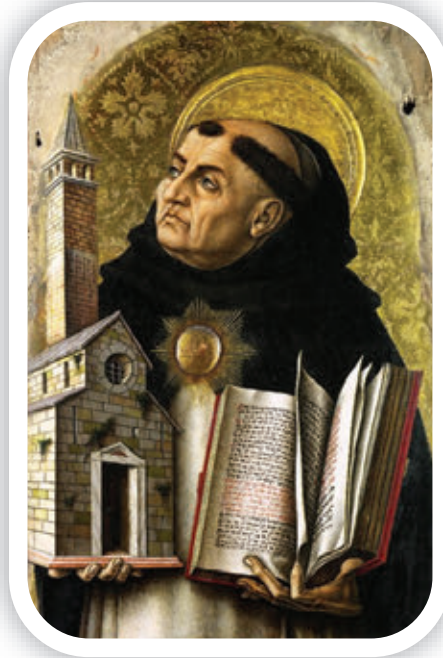

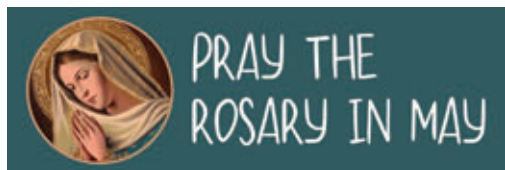
To date, we have \$2,350.00 in the pot.

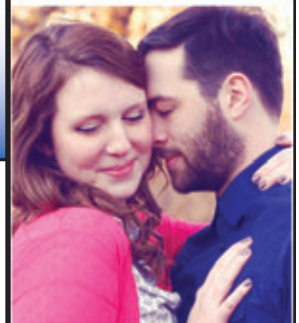
