

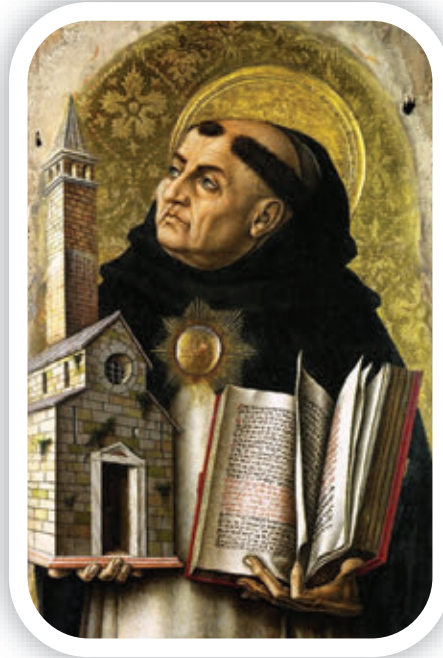

Dear Parishioners,

Welcome back from your summer vacation or staycation! Before I get to news and upcoming events, I want to express my gratitude to those who labored over the summer on behalf of the parish. I am grateful to those who helped maintain our parish gardens. I am happy to report that we had a bumper crop of tomatoes this year! Figs should be ripening soon! Bernadette Colvin continues to clean the church all by herself every week. Gerri McGuire faithfully changed the altar linens despite her husband's recent illness and eventual death. Our Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Altar Servers, Cantors, and Altar Society worked to enrich your summer Liturgies. The St. Vincent de Paul Society stayed open to respond to the needs of those affected by the pandemic and the recent flooding.

Speaking of the pandemic, the Delta Variant continues to spread. However, fully vaccinated people have a very small chance of becoming seriously ill or being hospitalized. In light of this, we want to restart some parish events:

- PREP—our Parish Religious Education Program for public and charter school students—opens on Thursday, September 9<sup>th</sup> at St. Thomas Aquinas School.
- RCIA—the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults—will begin again in late September. If you know of anyone who would like to become a Catholic or hasn't received all their sacraments of initiation, please ask them to call the parish office. Unbaptized adults are fully initiated into the Church during the Easter Vigil. Others can be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church during the Easter season.
- Our Annual Parish Picnic will be held on Sunday, September 12<sup>th</sup> at Noon. Many thanks to Mark Martin and Marie Kelly for co-chairing this event.
- Sunday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> is the Blessing of Animals at 12:30PM in front of the gazebo. Rain or shine!
- The Sunday Social will resume on Sunday, October 17<sup>th</sup> immediately after the 11AM Mass.
- Designer Bag Bingo is Saturday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>
- Our Parish Memorial Mass will be offered on Saturday, November 6<sup>th</sup> at 4:30PM. We will remember all those who have died over the past twelve months.
- Soup and Conversation is Sunday, November 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Our Annual Christmas Bazaar is Sunday, November 28<sup>th</sup>. Shop till you drop!

Here is the latest news:

- Our Parish Survey indicates overwhelming support for removing the artwork that surrounds the crucifix behind the main altar. Surveys were mailed to all active households. 158 families responded. 252 people voted. 184 people or 73% voted to remove the artwork. 68 people or 27% voted to keep the artwork. The project will begin early next year.
- The Bristol Township Zoning Board voted down our proposal to build town houses where the school now stands. We are currently considering our options and preparing a response.
- Our Parish Lottery was a stunning success! We sold over 800 tickets and raised over \$10,000. Our top seller who wishes to remain anonymous sold 121 tickets!
- New windows were installed in the church sacristy. The previous windows were made of 65-year-old single-pane glass and were very drafty. Funds for this project came from your generous donations to our Annual Block Collection.
- On Saturday, August 14<sup>th</sup> the Parish Office Building was broken into. It's not certain what, if anything, was stolen. Video of the break-in was saved by our security cameras. Police say that the suspect appeared high at the time of the incident. The next day a suspect was apprehended after he broke into the Croydon CVS. At this time, it appears that the same person will be charged with both crimes.
- The Most Reverend Nelson Perez, Archbishop of Philadelphia, will offer a Mass of Thanksgiving at St. Thomas on Sunday, May 1<sup>st</sup> at 11AM as we celebrate the 65<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the dedication of our church. Please spread the word to alumni and former parishioners. A catered lunch will follow in the parish hall. Tickets for that lunch will go on sale after Christmas.

Welcome back! Support your parish with your time, talent, and treasure, and pray for an end to the pandemic and a return of the majority to the practice of their Catholic Faith!

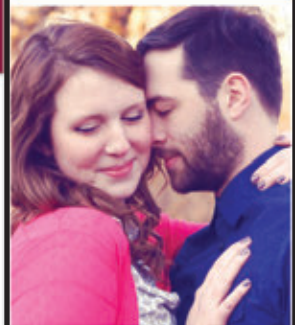
