It can be any president they want, except Washington or Lincoln, a favorite president or a president they just want to learn more about. Please have them:

1. Include a sentence with the years that their president was the president.
2. Write a sentence about what number president they were.
3. Write three or more sentences they would like to share with the class or write about that happened to their president, as long as it is factual.
4. Include a photo of their president so when they present their report to the class we can see what that president looked like.

I have included a list on the back of this sheet of all the presidents to choose from.

This report is due at the end of the month on Friday, February 21. We look forward to everyone sharing and telling us all about their president!!!
