Dear Parents and Guardians of St. John the Evangelist School,

Catholic Schools Week: Catholic Schools Week is off to a great start. It was wonderful to see so many families at church this weekend. The students have been enjoying all the special themes and activities planned by the teachers. Pictures can be seen on our social media accounts on Facebook and Instagram.

Valentine's Day: There has been an update to our Valentine's Day guidelines. The students will still not be able to have a class party that involves food. However, individual teachers may plan parties that include games and crafts. **Valentines will now be allowed to be passed out.** However, the following guidelines must be followed: Valentines may be created at individual homes. Regardless of their origin, valentines should be placed in a container (bag, box, etc.) that is individualized and labeled for each student. If envelopes are used, they should not be sealed through licking. Envelopes can be sealed by moist sponges, tape, etc. Once valentines have been collected, containers should sit untouched at the school for at least 48 hours before given to students. **Thus, teachers must collect valentines by Wednesday, February 10 so that they can be distributed on Friday, February 12.** Valentines may not contain food, candy, or any other edible treat from individual family homes. They may contain non-edible treats if allowed to sit out for at least 48 hours. Any valentines that contain food will be sent back home with the student. Any Valentines that arrive after February 10th will not be able to be passed out until the week of February 16th.

Registration for 2021-2022 School Year: This is just a reminder that if you did not inform the office that you will not be returning next year, you will see your registration fees for the 2021-2022 school year on your March tuition statement (goes out in February).
