MESSAGE FROM FATHER JOE:

Let us start this New Year 2020 by listening to the wisdom that comes from the mouths of little ones. Please make sure to take a note the next time your child tells you something that makes you ponder. Unlike adults children are quick and they always speak their minds. Here are some examples:

TEACHER: "George Washington not only chopped down his father's cherry tree, but also admitted it. Now Louie, do you know why his father didn't punish him? LOUIS: "Because George still had the axe in his hand...." (Down to earth!)

TEACHER: "Now Simon, tell me frankly, do you say prayers before eating?" SIMON: "No sir, I don't have to, my mom is a good cook." (So practical)

TEACHER: "Clyde, your composition on 'My Dog' is exactly the same as your brother's... did you copy his?" CLYDE: "No sir. It's about the same dog." (I want to adopt this kid!)

TEACHER: "Harold, what do you call a person who keeps on talking when people are no longer interested?" HAROLD: "A teacher!" (Really frank!)
