MESSAGE FROM FATHER JOE:

The poem below "The Cold Within" by James Kinney, is about six people who by coincidence are stuck in the cold, with a burning fire whose flame is about to burn out, if one of the six people does not put their stick of wood inside the fire. All the people in the poem are from different backgrounds, making it hard for any person to put his stick into the fire, because of their grudges towards the other members in the groups' affiliations.

Six humans trapped by happenstance, In dark and bitter cold
Each possessed a stick of wood-- Or so the story's told.

Their dying fire in need of logs, But the first one held hers back,
For, of the faces around the fire, She noticed one was black.

The next one looked cross the ways, Saw one not of his church,

The third one sat in tattered clothes, He gave his coat a hitch,
Why should his log be put to use, To warm the idle rich?

The rich man just sat back and thought, Of wealth he had in store,
