To go forward we need a competent person to fill in the vacuum created by the retirement of Pat Janulewicz. Through this column I am inviting applications to fill the vacant post of administrative assistant at Resurrection parish, Grand Island.

The post of administrative assistant at Resurrection parish is a part time job, with a maximum of 20 hours per week. The working hours can be flexible; 4 morning hours from 8 or 9 am is by a panel before appointment to the post, with a probationary period of 90 days before confirmation in the position.

Applicant should be computer savvy, be familiar with MS Office and its applications. Reasonable knowledge of office procedures, correspondence, parish sacramental data recording and storage, payroll prep, parish bulletin prep and liturgical scheduling, basic accounting procedures and fundamentals of finance management are expected from the applicant. Familiarity with Quick Books accounting software would be an added advantage. Learning relevant software on the job can be considered.
