### RITE OF CONFIRMATION

**RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES** | Candidates ONLY Stand

**RESPONSE TO EACH QUESTION: I DO!**

**Do you reject Satan and all his works and all his empty promises?**

**Do you believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth?**

**Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the father?**

**Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who came upon the apostles at Pentecost and today is given to you sacramentally in confirmation?**

**Do you believe in the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?**

### AN OINTING WITH SACRED CHRISM

The priest will approach the candidates and sponsors. In front of the priest, the sponsors place their right hand on the right shoulder of their candidate.

The candidates tells the priest their confirmation name.

**PRIEST:** “[Name of confirmandi] be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit.”

**NEWLY CONFIRMED:** AMEN!

**PRIEST:** “Peace be with you”

**NEWLY CONFIRMED:** And with your Spirit!
