Our Annual Veterans Mass will be celebrated on **Saturday September 18th at 12:15PM**. This year's Mass will be honoring the **13 U.S. Service Members** who gave their lives helping others, in **Afghanistan**, and, for those who were left behind. We will also be reading of the names, of the Veterans, on the newly installed Bricks, at our Veterans Memorial. These new bricks include: A brick array honoring **Deacon Joe Melita**, "ST Margaret Shrine's first Deacon" and a decorated WWII veteran. Bricks honoring the **"Four Chaplains"** of WWII, who gave their lives so that others may live. And a brick honoring **"81 South Vietnamese Paratroopers"** that could not be buried in their own country. They remained without a country for 54 years. Until they were finally buried in California in 2019. In order to insure installation by Veterans Day 2021, the last day to donate a Veteran's Brick will be September 25th 2021. Bricks may be donated for U.S. Veterans and our allies. War-time, peacetime, active duty, or reserve.
