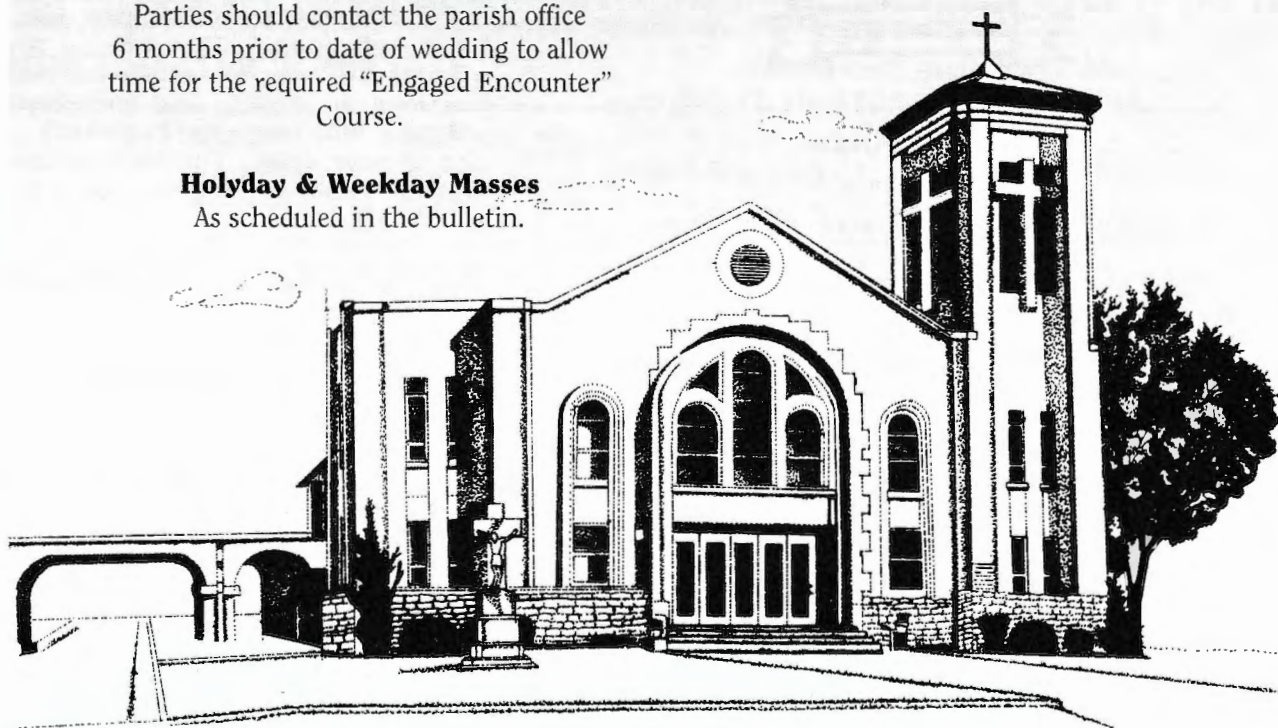

We are not only to keep from killing people; we are not to even be angry with anyone. Large order! I suspect we all have a long way to go to fill it. So let's get started. Let's really get serious about loving one another, from deep down within our souls.
