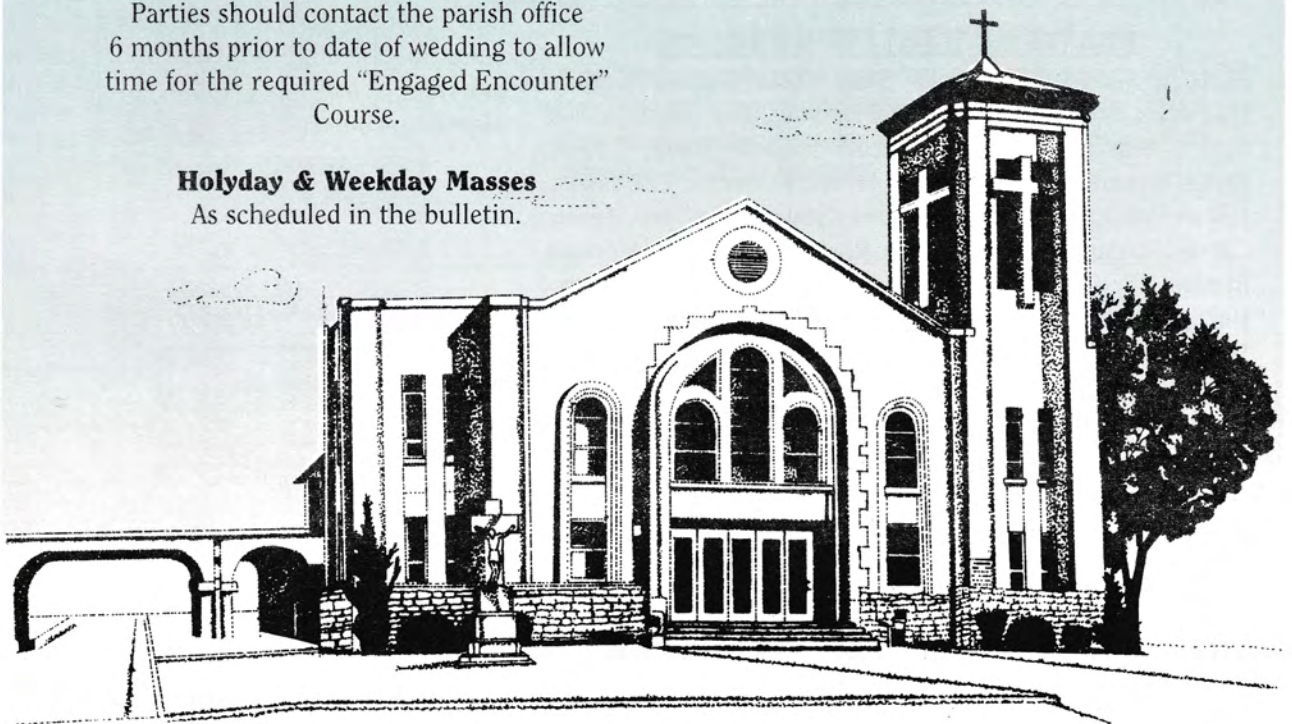

## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for the many kind birthday wishes, cards, food, and bottles of hydration. I shouldn't be thirsty for awhile.

As we enter into the month of October, we are encouraged by the Church to pray the rosary. The reason October is called the Month of the Rosary is because of the feast day of Our Lady of the Rosary, which is celebrated on October 7th. This is a very special day for us in this diocese because Our Lady of the Rosary is the principal patroness for the Diocese of Victoria (Our Lady of Guadalupe is the secondary patroness). Formerly, Our Lady of the Rosary was known as Our Lady of Victory and recall this is the name of our cathedral church in Victoria. In 1571, Pope Pius V encouraged all Catholics to pray the rosary for a Christian victory over the invading Muslim army. The Ottoman Empire was expanding westward and conquering everyone in their path. The Christian army intercepted the Muslims at the Battle of Lepanto and the Christian army did prevail.

There are two very significant things about this victory: 1) it was wholly unexpected. The Muslim army had vastly superior warships and more of them than the Christians. They also had twice as many men fighting. It truly was a David vs. Goliath type of naval battle. No one expected the Christians to win, but they did. In fact, there's a little joke that the pope didn't know what else to do but pray, since victory was not expected. 2) The other extremely important fruit of this victory is that it preserved Christianity throughout Europe. As we know, Europe is a historically Catholic Christian continent. All the countries in Europe have Catholicism deep in their roots. Most historians agree that if the Muslim army won the Battle of Lepanto, then Europe would have eventually been converted to Islam and all of the western world would look vastly different than it is today. Think about that. There's a very, very legitimate chance we would have a mosque here in Schulenburg instead of St. Rose or we wouldn't have the painted churches in High Hill, Ammannsville, Dubina, or Praha and we wouldn't be Catholic. It cannot be emphasized enough just how significant for our faith was this Christian victory. And so, when you hear about Our Lady of the Rosary (or Our Lady of Victory, they're synonymous), this is what it all entails.

Therefore, I would like to invite all of you to join us in the praying of the rosary, Sunday afternoon at 3pm on October 10th. Throughout our country, rosary rallies are being held that day to pray the rosary and to pray for our country. We will have exposition and benediction included. The rosary is the best way to honor the Blessed Mother and a very powerful weapon. Just google the Battle of Lepanto to see what praying the rosary can do. We all watch the news and see what's going on. This is a great opportunity, as a people of faith, to join together in praying the rosary for the protection and conversion of our country, just as our ancestors gathered 450 years ago to pray for their beloved Europe.
