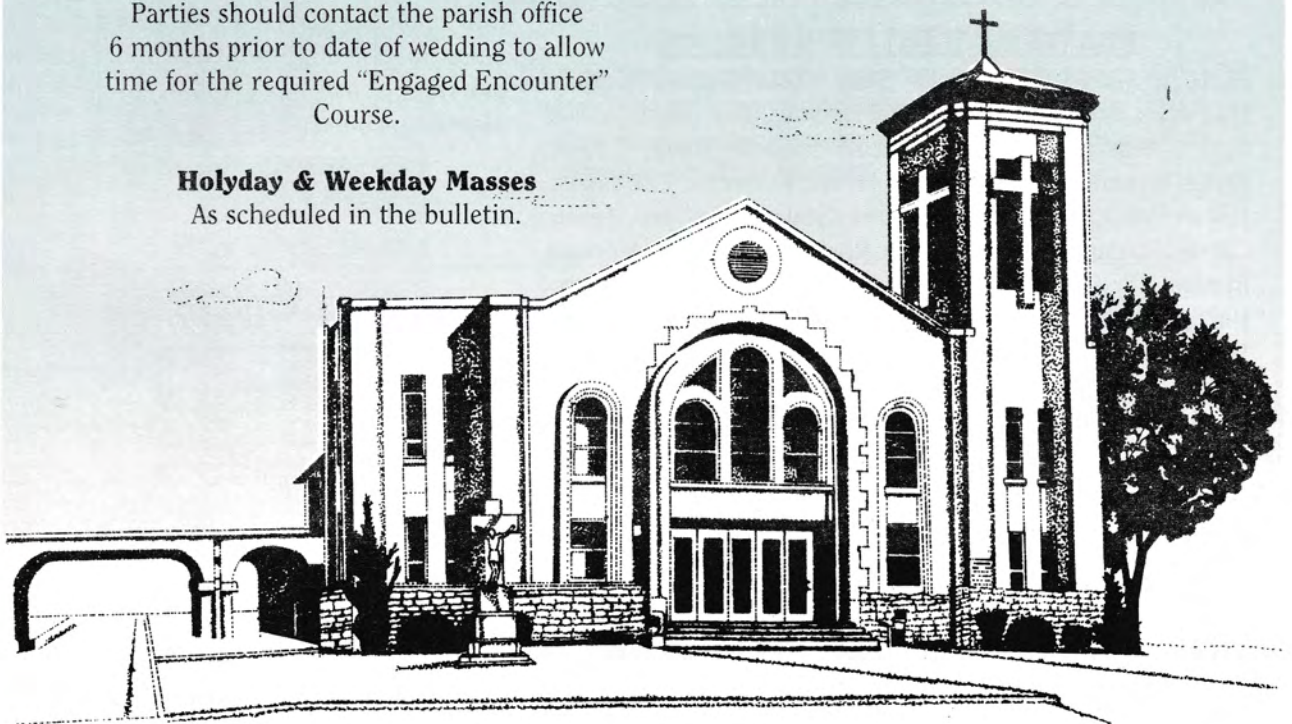

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, I would like to welcome once again Deacon Jay Vocelka. Dcn. Jay and his wife, Gloria, reside in the High Hill area and he will be predominantly assisting the priests and community out there. However, you will see him periodically around St. Rose. Therefore, to understand better what a "deacon" actually is and what his purpose is, I asked Dcn. Jay to write about the role of a deacon in the life of the Church. The following is from him.

UNDERSTANDING THE DIACONATE

The question most commonly used when inquiring about Deacons in the Catholic Church is "What is a Deacon?" The more appropriate question is: "WHO is a Deacon?"

Simply stated a Deacon is one who has responded to a call from God for a life of ministerial service within the Church.

In the Catholic Church, through the Sacrament of Holy Orders he receives an indelible imprint on the soul and a specific sacramental grace which configures him to Christ, who made himself servant of all. Out of respect for their office, members of the Episcopacy are addressed as "Bishop" and those in the Presbyterate as "Father." The proper address of those members of the Diaconate is "Deacon."

The theological identity of a Deacon is defined "as a participation in the one ecclesiastical ministry, he is a specific sacramental sign, in the Church, of Christ the servant." (Dogmatic Constitution on the Church).

Deacons - both transitional and permanent - are members of the clergy whose special role is to assist the Bishop of the local diocese and his priests; they are not "glorified" acolytes (altar servers).

At Mass it belongs to the Deacon to offer the invocations of the Penitential Rite, proclaim the Gospel, read the petitions of the General Intercessions, receive the gifts, prepare the altar with the sacred vessels, and dismiss the assembly. By virtue of his ordination the Deacon may preach and is an ordinary minister of Holy Communion, alongside the priest; he is not an extra-ordinary minister.

Outside of Mass he administers the Sacrament of Baptism; brings Viaticum to the dying; presides at prayer services; officiates at wakes, funerals, and burial services; and witnesses marriages. Deacons are able to bless religious articles, homes, and impart blessings on people.

As ministers of service Deacons may be found visiting and ministering to the sick; caring for inmates in prisons and jails; conducting sacramental preparation and religious education classes; and various administrative duties just to name a few.

Wherever they may be, deacons are dedicated to eliminating the injustices or inequities in the world.

But no matter what specific functions a deacon performs, they flow from his sacramental identity. In other words, it is not only WHAT a deacon does, but WHO a deacon is which is important. #
