Meditation for the Week

"As we honor our fathers today we hear Jesus reassure his disciples by reminding them of the tender care of his heavenly Father. Our heavenly Father watches over us assiduously, faithfully, lovingly; every hair on our heads is accounted for. Let us recall all the times our own fathers, grandfathers, uncles, and father figures—living and deceased—made us feel safe and secure with their vigilant care." (Pastoral Patterns)

Romans 5:12–15 By grace, the gracious gift of God's Son, Jesus Christ, has saved us all from sin.
