- Do I try to bring peace into the life of my spouse?
- Do I care for my spouse in actions?
- Have I physically harmed my spouse?
- Did I lead my spouse into sin?
- Have I been angry or resentful toward my spouse?
- Have I harbored hatred in my heart for my spouse?
- Have I entered into an emotional relationship with the opposite sex?
- Have I lied to my spouse?
- Was I sincere in my dealings with my spouse?
- Am I critical, negative or uncharitable in my thoughts of my spouse?
- Do I share with others (family, friends, co-workers) what should be kept confidential in our marriage?
- Have I engaged in impure reading, movies, television, conversation or curiosity?
- Have I been jealous of my spouse?
