THE 2020 CENSUS will begin mid-March when the US Census Bureau sends a mailing inviting households to self-respond to the Census via online, over the phone, or mail in paper form. The Census is 10 simple questions, and takes only 10 minutes to complete! Census data is used to distribute federal and state funding. Locally, Carrington stands to lose \$500,000 in critical infrastructure funding from the state if our population falls below 2,000. By law, the Census is confidential for 72 years and your answers cannot be used against you or by any government agency or court. We are COUNTING on YOU to complete the 2020 Census.
