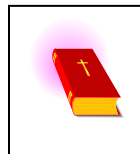

This registration is for preschool through high school. To enroll in the preschool program, your child must be four years old by September 1, 2020. The cost for the CCD & CYO program per family is \$40.00 for 1 student, \$80.00 for 2 students, \$120.00 for 3 students and \$140.00 for 4 or more students.
