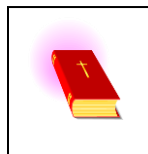

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION BUDGET: Recently, the religious education program budget for 2020-2021 was prepared and reviewed. In the school year, 2019-2020 our religious education income was \$5,030.00 and our expenses were \$7,732.63 leaving a negative balance of \$2,702.63. We received \$140.00 from a parishioner recently, so our loss is \$2,562.63 at this time. Would anyone be willing to donate towards the religious education program to offset the loss of \$2,562.63 from last year?
