▼ BAKE SALE THIS WEEKEND – CHECK IT OUT

CCD/CYO ACTIVITY FUND BAKE SALE: This weekend, Oct. 17th and 18th after Mass in the parish hall, we will be having a bake sale to raise money for our CCD/CYO Activity Fund. This is a free will offering. This money is used for CCD/CYO activities, such as bowling, swimming, movies, CYO Christmas party, etc.

CCD/CYO CLASSES: No class this week (Oct. 21st) because of Teacher’s Convention. Class as usual next week (Oct. 28th). **As a reminder, the following guidelines were implemented by the Board of Education.** A letter went home on the new policies last week.

- **Attendance:** If a student doesn’t attend school on the day of CCD class due to an illness or being identified as a close contact/quarantined person, they will not be allowed to attend CCD classes that day.
- **Face Coverings:** Students from grades 7-12 (and teachers) will now be required to wear face coverings (no gators) during CCD classes. This is in line with the new high school policy and the new executive order given by the Governor on September 30th.

“SOMETHING NEW” SACRED HEART HOMILY NOTES (FOR GRADES 4-12): There are “Homily Notes” sheets in the back of church to pick up (or on our website to run off) and **start filling the sheets out.** A letter was mailed home regarding the details. The top three classes with the most attendance at Mass will get a pizza and ice cream party at the end of the CCD-CYO school year. Grades P-3rd will be eligible for the party by filling out the Kids and Gospel sheets, which are also available in the back of the church for the Saturday night Mass attendance students.
