**CCD/CYO CLASSES: Wednesdays from 7-8 p.m. If you have not paid for your student's books, please do so as soon as possible.** The cost for the CCD & CYO program per family is \$40.00 for 1 student, \$80.00 for 2 students, \$120.00 for 3 students and \$140.00 for 4 or more students. **As a reminder, the following guidelines were implemented by the Board of Education.** A letter went home on the new policies a week ago.

- **Attendance:** If a student doesn't attend school on the day of CCD class due to an illness or being identified as a close contact/quarantined person, they will not be allowed to attend CCD classes that day.
- **Face Coverings:** Students from grades 7-12 (and teachers) will now be required to wear face coverings (no gators) during CCD classes. This is in line with the new high school policy and the new executive order given by the Governor on September 30<sup>th</sup>.

**LIVING ROSARY: On Wed., Oct. 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:35 p.m.** the CCD/CYO students (grades 2-11) will be praying a living rosary in the church. This will teach our youth more about the life of Christ and how to incorporate His life into their own. The students will be standing around the perimeter of the church, each taking a part reciting the rosary. We encourage you and your family and friends to join us in helping the children strengthen and live their faith.

**"SOMETHING NEW" SACRED HEART HOMILY NOTES (FOR GRADES 4-12):** There are "Homily Notes" sheets in the back of church to pick up (or on our website to run off) and **start filling the sheets out.** A letter was mailed home regarding the details. The top three classes with the most attendance at Mass will get a pizza and ice cream party at the end of the CCD-CYO school year. Grades P-3<sup>rd</sup> will be eligible for the party by filling out the Kids and Gospel sheets, which are also available in the back of the church for the Saturday night Mass attendance students.
