CCD/CYO CLASSES: Wed. from 7-8 p.m. As a reminder, the following guidelines were implemented by the Board of Education. A letter went home on the new policies.

- **Attendance:** If a student doesn't attend school on the day of CCD class due to an illness or being identified as a close contact/quarantined person, they will not be allowed to attend CCD classes that day.
- **Face Coverings:** Students from grades 7-12 (and teachers) will now be required to wear face coverings (no gators) during CCD classes. This is in line with the new high school policy and the new executive order given by the Governor on September 30th.
 - **UPDATE: CITY MANDATE: Face Coverings:** Because of the recent Carrington Mask Mandate effective November 10, 2020, students and teachers in all grades will now be required to wear face coverings (no gators) during CCD classes.

ATTENTION CCD PARENTS: Again this year the CCD classes have chosen to take part in the Giving Tree Program. We ask that the students bring their money (nickels, dimes, quarters, etc.) each week **to their classes by Dec. 2nd**.
