MARCH FOR LIFE: The Dioceses of Fargo and Bismarck, along with the University of Mary and many Catholic schools in our state, are planning a **North Dakota March for Life at the Capitol grounds in Bismarck on January 29, 2021 at 12:30 p.m.** All North Dakota Catholic High Schools are planning to have some of their student body present at this event. Every participant will wear a mask and social distancing will be observed. Mass will be offered at several Bismarck parishes shortly before the march. The centerpiece of the short program at the Capitol will be a period of silence for the 62 million babies aborted in the United States since the Roe v. Wade decision.
