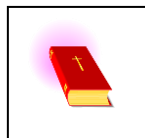
## HOLY FATHER'S PRAYER INTENTIONS FOR FEBRUARY:

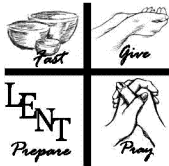
**WEEKDAY MASS:** During Lent, weekday Mass will be at 7:15 am every day Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
