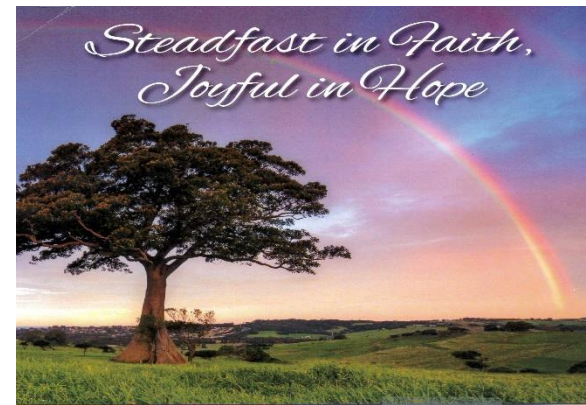
▼ PLEASE SIGN UP TO HELP AT SPRING DINNER
