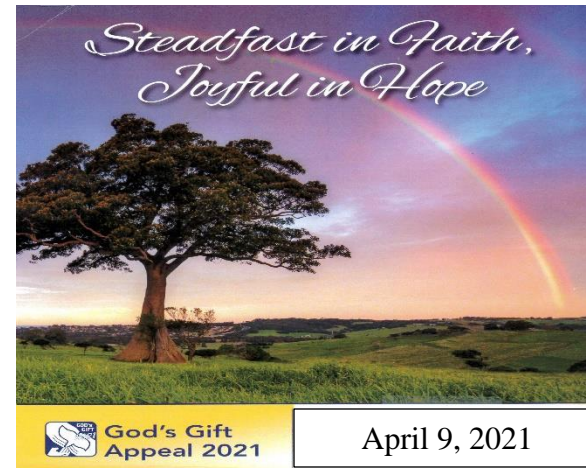
**▼ PLEASE SIGN UP TO HELP AT SPRING DINNER (NEXT SUNDAY)**
