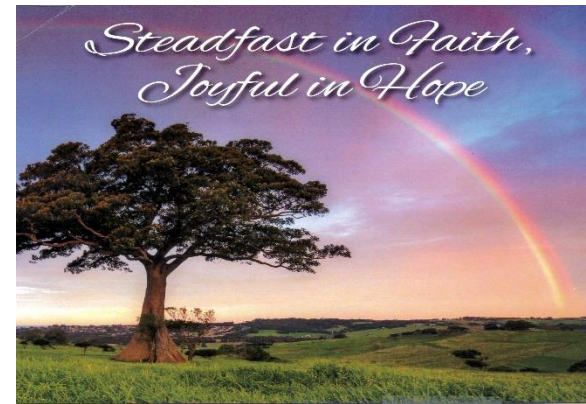
◆ **SPRING DINNER – TODAY, SUNDAY APRIL 25TH** ◆
