**WEEKLY PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL PETITIONS:** That our daily actions reflect our goal of good discipleship.

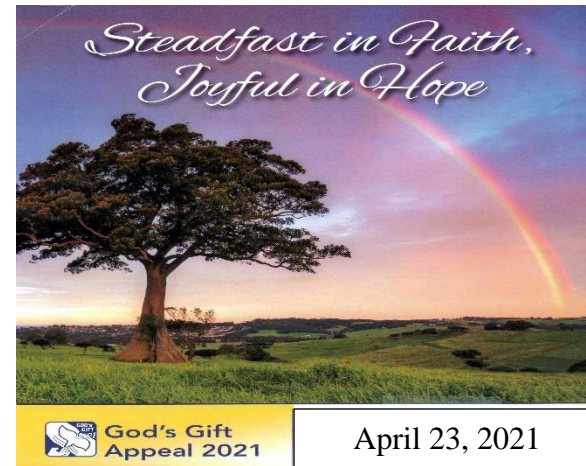
