ALTAR SERVER RECOGNITION will be held at the Masses next weekend, May 15th & 16th.

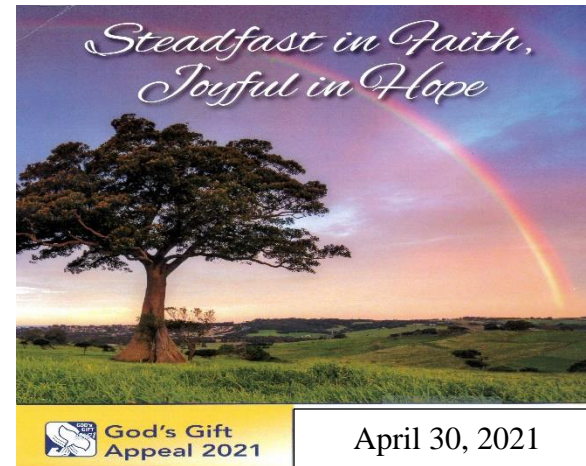

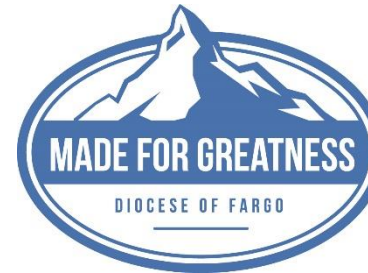
